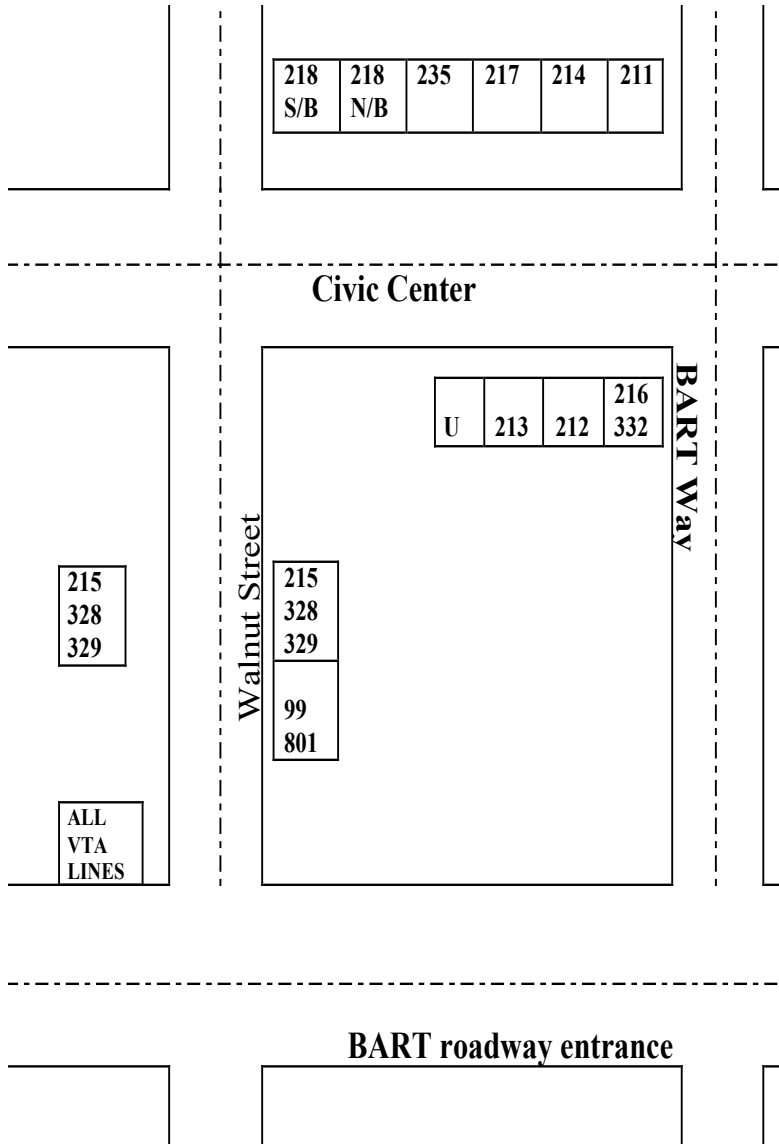




STOP LOCATIONS AT FREMONT BART



In the event of a BART strike, AC Transit buses will not enter BART property. Bus stops will be located on nearby streets.

STOP LOCATIONS

Southbound Civic Center Dr. between Walnut Ave. and BART Way, in front of the Gateway Plaza parking lot:

Northbound Civic Center Dr. at the corner of BART Way:

- Line 216**

Westbound Walnut Ave. at the end of the BART roadway entrance:

- Line 328** (to Fremont Hub and Chapel Way)
- Line 329** (to Lido Faire)

Eastbound Walnut Ave., across the street from the BART roadway entrance:

- Line 328** (to Mission Blvd.)
- Line 329** (to Chapel Way)

BUS ALTERNATIVES FROM FREMONT BART

SAN FRANCISCO

Weekday morning commute: Take Line 213 to Cedar St. and Mowry Ave. or Line 214 to Cedar St. and Stevenson Blvd. There, take Transbay Line SB. (Take either the Line 213 or 214 bus departing at 7:11 a.m. to catch the last Line SB, departing Cedar St. and Stevenson Blvd. at 7:39 a.m.).

Weekday mid-day and afternoon commute: Take line 99, 211 or 216 to Union City BART. There, take Dumbarton Express DB to Palo Alto CalTrain. There, take CalTrain to San Francisco. Or, take line 211 or 216 to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Emeryville Amtrak, and transfer to Amtrak bus to San Francisco. (See note on Amtrak)

Weekday evenings: Take Line 99 to Bayfair BART. Take lines 40 or 50 to Eastmont Transit Center. There, take Transbay Line NL.

Weekends: Take Line 218 to Mowry Ave. & Thornton Blvd. and walk one-quarter mile south to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Emeryville Amtrak, and transfer to Amtrak bus to San Francisco. (See note on Amtrak) Or, take Line 99 to Bayfair BART. Take lines 40 or 50 to Eastmont Transit Center. There, take Transbay Line NL.

DOWNTOWN OAKLAND

Weekdays: Take line 211 or 216 to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Oakland-Jack London Square Amtrak, and transfer to line 72 or 72M for downtown Oakland. (See note on Amtrak) Or, take Line 99 to Bayfair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R for downtown Oakland.

Weekend daytime: Take Line 218 to Mowry Ave. & Thornton Blvd. and walk one-quarter mile south to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Oakland-Jack London Square Amtrak, and transfer to line 72 or 72M for downtown Oakland. (See note on Amtrak) Or, take Line 99 to Bayfair BART, and transfer to line 1 or 1R to downtown Oakland.

Evenings: Take Line 99 to Bayfair BART. There, transfer to Line 1 to downtown Oakland.

DOWNTOWN BERKELEY

Weekdays: Take line 211 or 216 to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Berkeley Amtrak, and transfer to Line 51 for downtown Berkeley. (See note on Amtrak) Or, take Line 99 to Bayfair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R for downtown Berkeley.

Weekend daytime: Take Line 218 to Mowry Ave. & Thornton Blvd. and walk one-quarter

mile south to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Berkeley Amtrak, and transfer to Line 51 for downtown Berkeley. (See note on Amtrak) Or, take Line 99 to Bayfair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R for downtown Berkeley.

Evenings: Take Line 99 to Bayfair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R for downtown Berkeley.

Amtrak Capitols operate only a few trains per day. Call 1-800-USA-RAIL or visit www.amtrak.com for more information. Ask the conductor on board the train for a free transfer to AC Transit local buses.
