
STOP LOCATIONS AT HAYWARD BART

In the event of a BART strike, AC Transit buses will not enter BART property. Bus stops will be located on nearby streets.





BUS ALTERNATIVES FROM HAYWARD BART

SAN FRANCISCO

Weekday morning commute only: Take lines 22, 83, 85, or 86 to Hesperian Blvd. There, catch Transbay Line S. (Last Line S leaves from West Winton Ave. and Hesperian Blvd. at 7:34 a.m.) Or, follow midday directions.

Weekday mid-day and afternoon commute: Take Greyhound to San Francisco. (See note on Greyhound.) Or, take Line M to Hillsdale Caltrain, and transfer to Caltrain to San Francisco.

Weekend daytime: Take Greyhound to San Francisco. (See note on Greyhound.) Or, take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART. There, take line 40 to Eastmont Transit Center and transfer to Transbay Line NL.

All evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART. There, take line 1 to Thomas L. Berkley Way (20th Street) and Broadway (Uptown Transit Center). There, take Transbay Line NL.

TRANSFERS TO TRANSBAY BUSES

To get a free transfer from a AC Transit local bus to an AC Transit Transbay bus, pay the full Transbay fare when you first get on the local bus, and ask for the transfer.

DOWNTOWN OAKLAND

During the day, take Greyhound to Oakland Greyhound and walk or take lines 18, 72, or 72M to downtown Oakland. (See note on Greyhound). Or, take Line 93 to Hayward Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Oakland-Jack London Square Amtrak, and transfer to line 58L, 72 or 72M for downtown Oakland. (See note on Amtrak.)

Or, take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART. There, take line 1 or 1R to downtown Oakland.

Evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART and transfer to Line 1 to downtown Oakland.

DOWNTOWN BERKELEY

During the day, take Line 93 to Hayward Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Berkeley Amtrak, and transfer to Line 51B to downtown Berkeley. (See note on Amtrak.)

Or, take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART and transfer to line 1 or 1R to downtown Berkeley.

Evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART and transfer to Line 1 to downtown Berkeley.

CALTRAIN

From the San Francisco Caltrain station, take Muni lines N, T, 10, 30, or 45 to downtown. For Caltrain information, call 511 or visit www.511.org.

AMTRAK

Amtrak Capitols and San Joaquins operate only a few trains per day – call 1-800-USA-RAIL or visit www.amtrak.com for more information. Ask the conductor on board the train for a free transfer to AC Transit local buses.

GREYHOUND

Greyhound buses operate between Hayward and San Francisco only a few times per day. Call 1-800-231-2222 or visit www. greyhound.com for more information.
