



# **BUS ALTERNATIVES FROM SOUTH HAYWARD BART**

### SAN FRANCISCO

Weekday morning commute: Take lines 22, 83 or 86 to Tennyson Rd. and Hesperian Blvd.. There, catch Transbay Line S. (Last Line S leaves at approximately 7:20 am.) Or, follow mid-day directions.

Weekday mid-day and afternoon commute: Take Line 99 to Union City BART. There, take Dumbarton Express DB to Palo Alto Caltrain, and transfer to Caltrain to San Francisco.

Weekday evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART. There, take line 1 to Thomas L. Berkley Way (20th Street) and Broadway (Uptown Transit Center). There, take Transbay Line NL.

Weekends: Same as weekday evenings. Or, take Line 99 to Hayward BART, and take Greyhound to San Francisco. (See note on Greyhound)

## **DOWNTOWN OAKLAND**

Weekday and weekend daytime: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R to downtown Oakland.

Evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to Line 1 to downtown Oakland.

## **DOWNTOWN BERKELEY**

Weekday daytime: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to line 1 or 1R for downtown Berkeley.

Weekends and evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to Line 1 for downtown Berkeley.

### **GREYHOUND**

Greyhound buses operate between Hayward and San Francisco only a few times per day. Call 1-800-231-2222 or visit www.greyhound. com for more information.

#### **CALTRAIN**

From the San Francisco Caltrain station, take Muni lines N, T, 10, 30, or 45 to downtown. For Caltrain information, call 511 or visit www.511.org.
