Bicycles on Transit

Rail/Ferries: Bicycles are allowed on all Bay Area ferries and nearly all rail lines. Exceptions are San Francisco Muni Metro, historic streetcars, and cable cars.

General: While bicycles are allowed on most transit services, there are some space limitations and, in some cases, times when bicycles are not allowed on board.

Clipper® is the convenient way to pay for transit rides in the Bay Area. The reloadable Clipper card stores value as cash and transit passes to pay your fare on AC Transit, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit, etc.

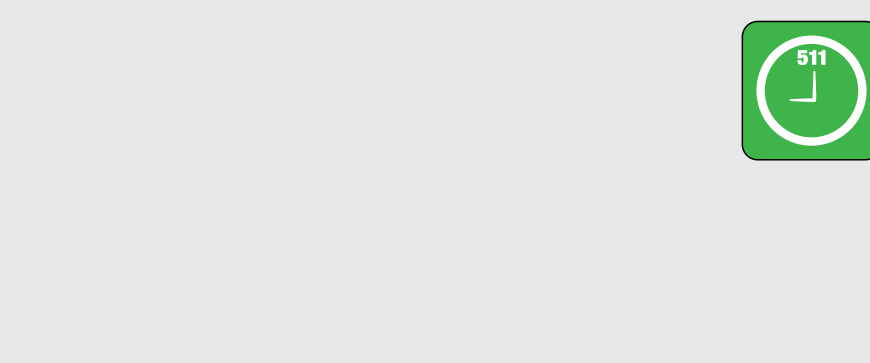
