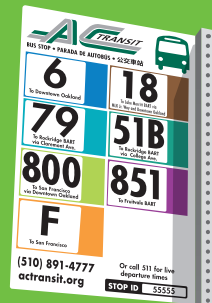

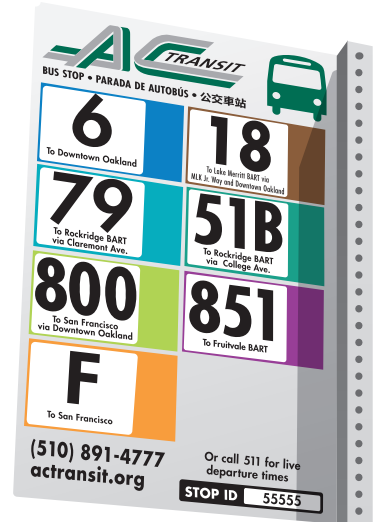

Words can be found in any direction (including diagonally) and can overlap each other.

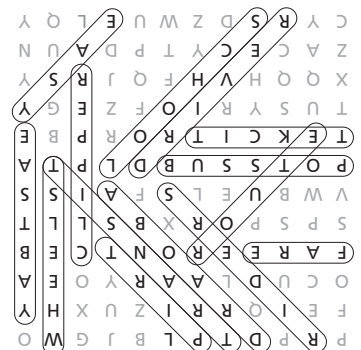

**adjective:**

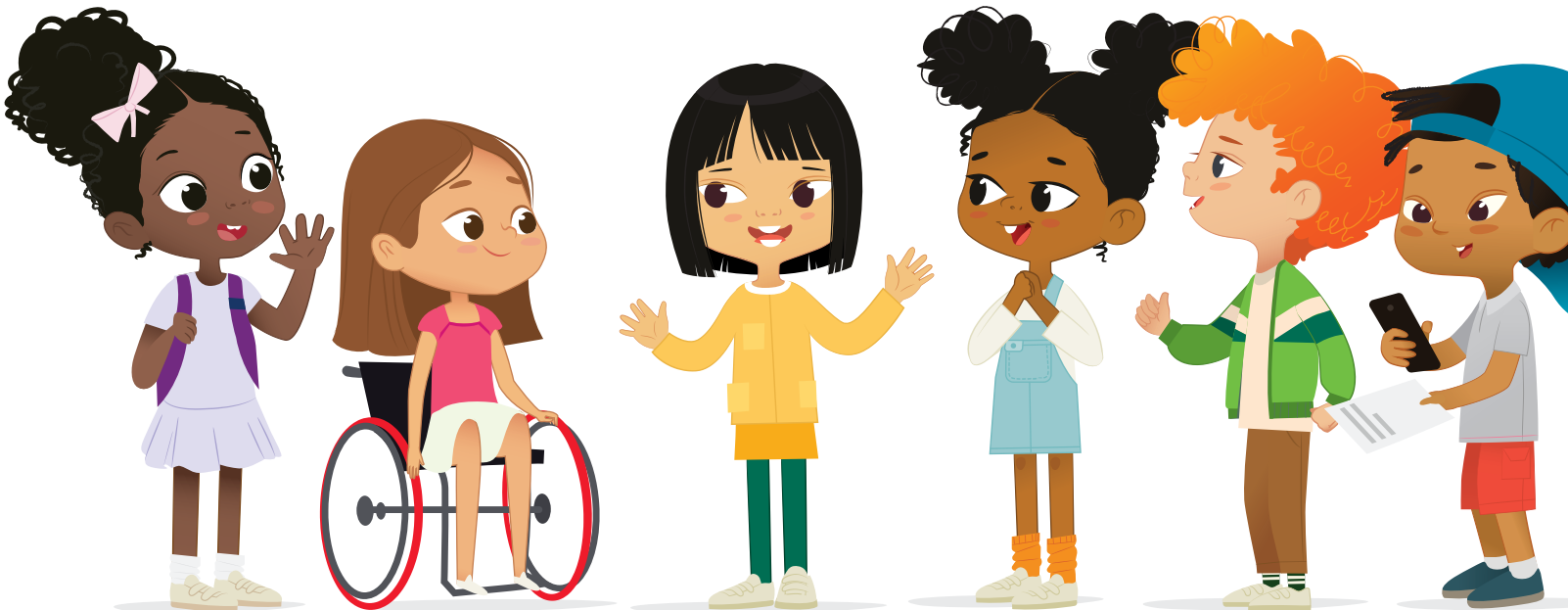
a word that describes a noun (like bad, blue, or wild)

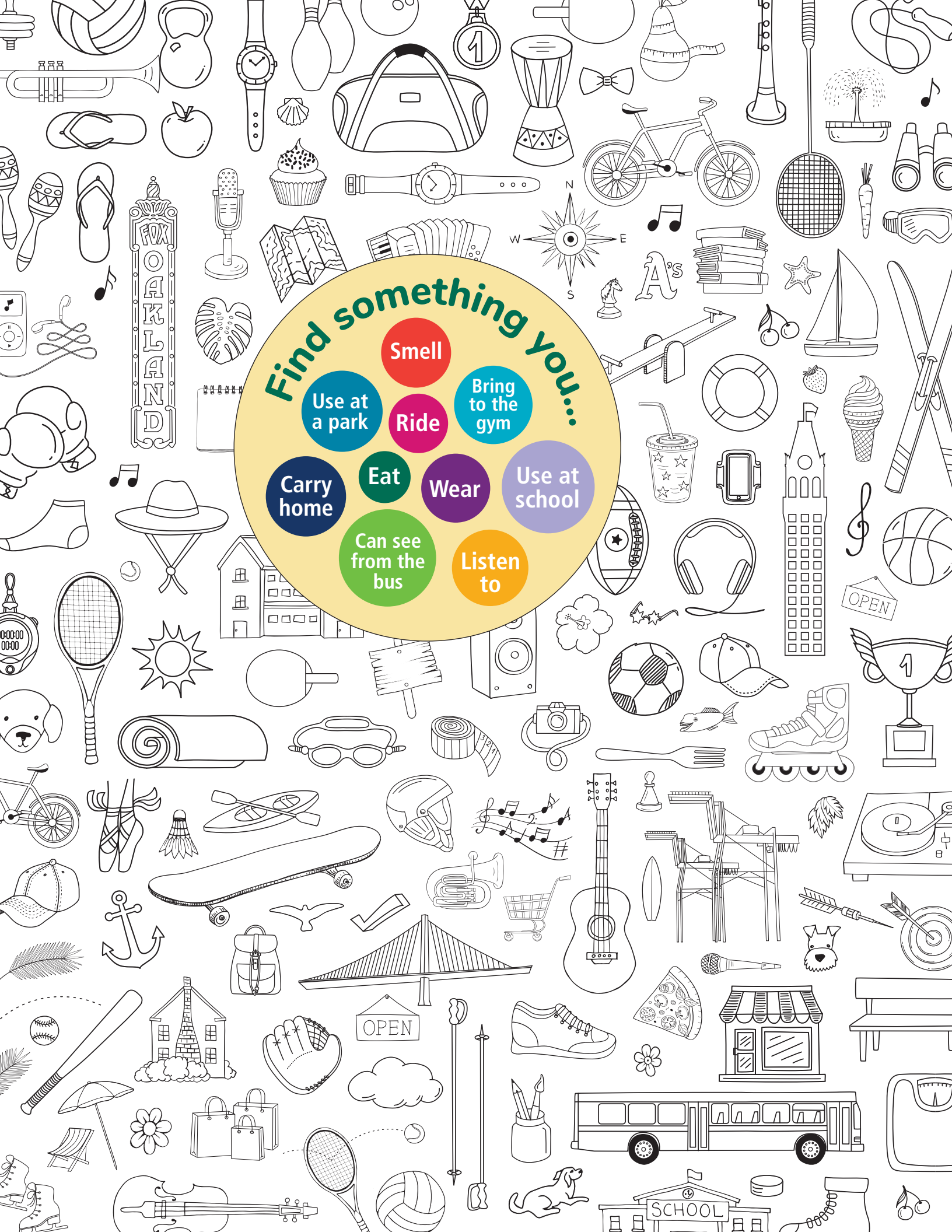
