A COI is an adjoining population that shares common social and economic interests that ideally should be included within a single ward for purposes of its effective and fair representation. These interests can include, but are not limited to income levels, educational backgrounds, cultural and language characteristics, and employment and economic patterns.

When you finish, just click "Share," and your map will be submitted and published to the public gallery.

Download the Excel template, complete with instructions, a locator map, and plan creator tool off of **ACTransit.org/Redistricting**. Use these tools to draw your ward boundaries and describe your map.
