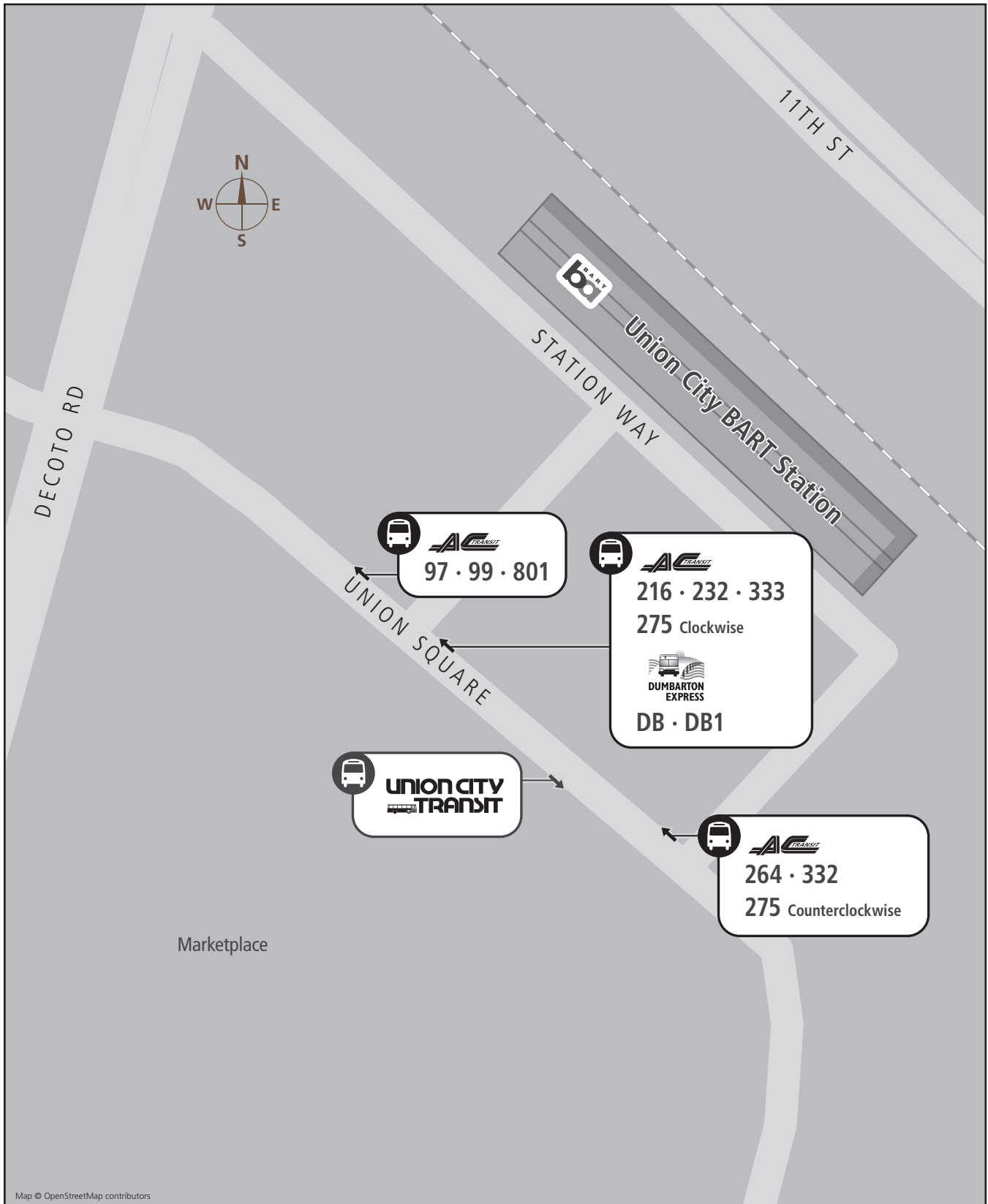


STOP LOCATIONS AT UNION CITY BART

In the event of a BART strike, AC Transit buses will not enter BART property. Bus stops will be located on nearby streets.





BUS ALTERNATIVES FROM UNION CITY BART

SAN FRANCISCO

Weekday morning commute: Take Dumbarton Express lines DB or DB1 to Ardenwood Park & Ride, Line 232 to Ardenwood Blvd. and Paseo Padre Parkway, or Line 275 to Newark Blvd. and Jarvis Ave. There, take Transbay Line SB. (Last Line SB leaves at 7:41 a.m.) Or, follow mid-day directions.

Mid-days and weekday afternoons: Take Dumbarton Express DB to Palo Alto Caltrain. There, take Caltrain to San Francisco.

Weekday evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART. There, take line 1 to Thomas L. Berkeley Way (20th Street) and Broadway (Uptown Transit Center). There, transfer to Transbay Line NL.

Weekends: Same as weekday evenings. Or, take Line 99 to Hayward BART, and take Greyhound to San Francisco. (See note on Greyhound)

DOWNTOWN OAKLAND

Daytime: Take Line 99 to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Oakland-Jack London Square Amtrak, and transfer to line 58L, 72 or 72M for downtown Oakland. (See note on Amtrak below)

Or, take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to lines 1 or 1R to downtown Oakland.

All evenings: Take Line 99 to Bayfair BART. Transfer to Line 1 to downtown Oakland.

DOWNTOWN BERKELEY

Daytime: Take Line 99 to Fremont-Centerville Amtrak. Take Amtrak Capitols to Berkeley Amtrak, and transfer to Line 51B for downtown Berkeley. (See note on Amtrak below)

Or, take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to line 1 or 1R to downtown Berkeley. (Line 1R operates to downtown Berkeley weekdays only.)

All evenings: Take Line 99 to Bay Fair BART, and transfer to Line 1 for downtown Berkeley.

GREYHOUND

Greyhound buses operate between Hayward and San Francisco only a few times per day. Call 1-800-231-2222 or visit www.greyhound.com for more information.

CALTRAIN

From the San Francisco Caltrain station, take Muni lines N, T, 10, 30, or 45 to downtown. For Caltrain information, call 511 or visit www.511.org.

AMTRAK

Amtrak Capitols operate only a few trains per day. Call 1-800-USA-RAIL or visit www.amtrak.com for more information. Ask the conductor on board the train for a free transfer to AC Transit local buses.

TRANSFERS TO TRANSBAY BUSES

To get a free transfer from a AC Transit local bus to an AC Transit or Dumbarton Express Transbay bus, pay the full Transbay fare when you first get on the local bus, and ask for the transfer.
